United Irish of Southwest Florida General Membership Meeting January 9, 2023

Executive Committee present: President, Mike Faherty; Vice President, Kathy McAuliffe; Treasurer, Bill McAfee; and Secretary, Ruth Ann McAfee. Board Members present: Joe Nolan; Tom Sheehan and Membership Chairman, Anne Marie Farrell.

The meeting was drawn to order with 40 members at 7:15 P.M. by President, Mike Faherty, followed by the Pledge of Allegiance and the Lord's Prayer.

First order of business was the Secretary's report in which Ruth Ann McAfee stated the January Newsletter were delayed due to the printer being closed for the holidays in addition to there being no minutes for the December meeting since we did not have a quorum in December thus no meeting.

Second order of business was the Treasurer's report in which Bill McAfee stated January's beginning balance was \$5,781.15. After a deposit for membership fees of \$70.00 and expense of \$50.50 for printing the newsletter, our balance is presently \$5,801.65.

Membership was the next order of business. Anne Marie Farrell stated the present membership stands at 102 members. Anne also stated that last year at this time we had 137 members. Thus, Anne Marie made a plea to the membership to encourage them if they know anyone that has not renewed please talk to them and try to get them back to the club.

Discussion of the Caloosahatchee Irish Festival, coming up on January 27th and 28th concluded with the Board encouraging all to attend, giving the details of hours of operation and cost of entry.

Vice President, Kathy McAuliffe, gave a synopsis of the plan for a banner that, at the request and approval of Mr. Basta of Snapper's, will be posted in Snapper's to identify that venue as our club's "home". In addition, Kathy stated that she is still working on getting t-shirts printed with our logo to be worn for the Naples St. Patrick's Day parade. Ms. McAuliffe followed up with a plea to the membership for Board members. We are currently short a Board member. Secretary, Ruth Ann McAfee, continued the plea for a new Board member stating that serving on the Board is more fun than work. While Ms. McAfee was speaking, an attendee, Lauretta Dustin, volunteered for the Board position. Welcome, Lauretta!!

Mr. Faherty explained that Mr. Basta of Snapper's Comedy Club has volunteered to make Snapper's the Club's home. This suggestion was met with approval from the membership.

Joe Nolan announced that he is selling admission to the Hooley and the George Casey Comedy Night. Members were requested to see Joe through the night to make their reservations for these events.

Also, plans are in the works for a Whiskey Tasting which would be held at Snappers. Again, details are being worked out for that event.

With no further business to discuss, the meeting was closed at 7:40 p.m., and the floor was turned over to Harry Boyle, keeping the dance floor filled all night.
