Apology: This Secretary/Editor/Photographer apologizes for not having photos of our last 2 events. The camera disc became "corrupt" before the pictures could be downloaded. But, as appeasement, here's something to surely sweeten your mood:

"FIFTEENS" are a type of tray bake from Ulster, N. Ireland. The recipe's name derives from the fact that it is typically made with 15 digestive biscuits, 15 marshmallows and 15 glacé cherries, which are combined with condensed milk and desiccated coconut.

The delicacy is traditionally offered with other tray bakes, buns or biscuits and is commonly enjoyed with a cup of tea. Fifteens are seldom found outside Northern Ireland and County Donegal. They can be found in most coffee shops.

INGREDIENTS

15 digestive biscuits

15 marshmallows

15 glacé cherries, cut in half

about 200ml condensed milk

100g desiccated coconut, to coat

DIRECTIONS

STEP 1

Crush the digestive biscuits in a food processor or in a plastic bag with a rolling pin, then put them in a large mixing bowl. Chop each marshmallow into 4 pieces and add to the bowl with the cherries and 175ml condensed milk. Mix until the ingredients are well combined and you have a sticky mixture. If it's too dry, add a splash more condensed milk.

STEP 2

Sprinkle most of the coconut over a large piece of cling film (or foil). Tip the mixture onto the coconut and shape into a long sausage, about 30 x 5cm. Sprinkle more coconut over the top of it and wrap the cling film tightly around, twisting the ends together. Leave in the fridge to chill for 4-6 hrs, then cut into 15 slices and serve. Will keep in the fridge for up to 1 week wrapped in cling film.



United Irish of Southwest Florida General Membership Meeting March 13, 2023

Executive Committee present: President, Mike Faherty; Treasurer, Bill McAfee; and Secretary, Ruth Ann McAfee. Board Members present: Chairman, Joe Nolan; Tom Sheehan; Lauretta Dustin; and Membership Chairman, Anne Marie Farrell.

The meeting was drawn to order with 43 members at 7:15 P.M. by President, Mike Faherty, followed by the Pledge of Allegiance and the Lord's Prayer.

Mr. Faherty opened with remarks on the George Casey Comedy event which was very well attended and appreciated by the attendees. Kudos were conveyed to Snappers for hosting the event as well as selling tickets for us, and to members who worked to make the evening a success. Debbie Nelson, a nonmember from Cape Coral, was given special thanks for selling tickets and arranging transportation by bus for several people to attend this event.

Mr. Faherty asked if there were any new members present. Ginny Parsons, from Buffalo New York, introduced herself. We had one guest, Debbie from Cleveland Ohio.

New Business-Executive Reports:

Ruth Ann was asked for a Secretary's report. Ruth Ann made a request for a motion to accept the February minutes which were posted in the March Newsletter. Patrick Garvey made the motion and it was seconded by Tom Sheehan.

Joe Nolan was asked to give the details of the next event, which is the Tiki Hut lunch on March 15th. Bart Cournane will be the entertainment for that event. All were encouraged to attend.
